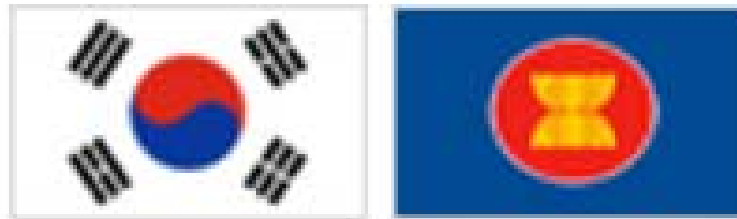

# Introduction

---



- **Water is a cross-cutting element that encompasses climate change, population, urbanization, food, energy, etc.**  
👉 **need for a more holistic & multi-dimensional solutions**
  - **The ASEAN region is prone to the water-related disasters as 80% of the region is surrounded by water: *e.g. cyclones in the Philippines, Myanmar; flooding in Indonesia***  
👉 **ASEAN continues to seek collaborative actions in order to build the region to be more resilient.**

# ROK's Cooperation at the Regional level



## ■ The ASEAN-ROK Cooperation Fund (since 1990-)

- Contribution: 7million USD per year, 81 Million USD by 2016
- 9 Priority Areas: Labor, ICT, Transnational Crime, Food and Agriculture, Disaster Management, Women, Environment, Social Welfare, People-to-People
  
- Relevant Projects
  - 1) *Building Resilience for Sustainable ASEAN*  
*From Water Related Disasters* by Chuncheon Global Water Forum
  - 2) *Restoration of Degraded Forest Ecosystems in Southeast Asian Tropical Regions* by ASEAN-KOREA Environmental Cooperation Project, Seoul National University

# ROK's Cooperation at the sub-regional level

---

- **The ROK-Mekong Cooperation Fund (since 2013-)**
    - **Contribution: 1million USD per year, 3.3million USD by 2016**
    - **6 Priority Areas: Infrastructure, ICT, Green Growth, Water Resource Development, Agriculture and Rural Development, Human Resource Development**
  
  - **ASEAN-ROK Forest Cooperation, AFoCO (2013-2015)**
    - **Contribution: 500,000 USD**
    - **Aim: to tackle the issue of deforestation and forest conservation in the context of sustainable development**

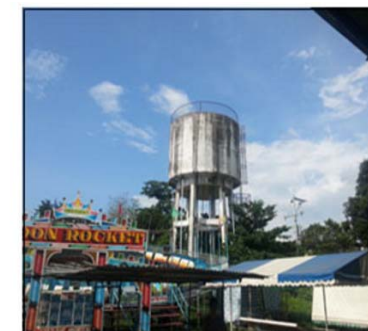
# ROK's Cooperation at the bilateral level
